CAs will gain research experience through assisting in fieldwork and data management on marine mammals, mangroves, fisheries, and coastal communities – as relevant to their interests and ongoing thesis work.

Training

CAs will participate in trainings on key conservation & research skills. These include opportunities for local and international learning exchange trips.

They will gain experience through **co-teaching training activities** for fellow students.

Campaigns

CAs will co-develop campaigns to link research to education and awareness-raising. Focus areas for 2019 campaigns are: plastic pollution and marine mammals.

Open to interested students (Bachelor's and graduate) from any department. Applicants should have:

- Passion for conservation research & action
- Good work ethic, reliability, willingness to commit time to the position
- Eagerness to learn
